All are invited to share in the storytelling from 6:15 to 8:15 p.m. on the second floor of the library.

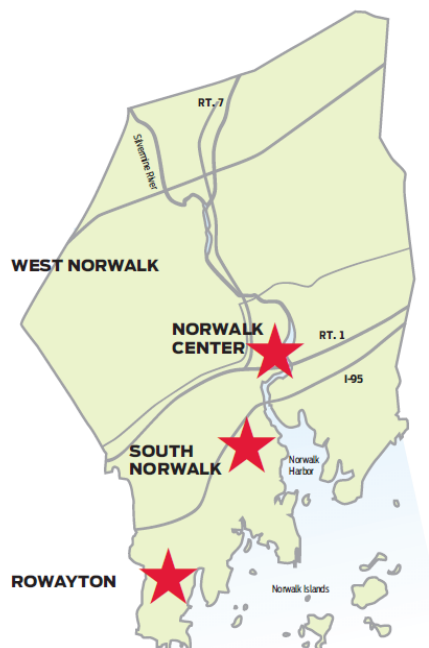
Space for the event is
