### Norwalk Public Library offers convenient services to the community

The Norwalk Public Library is excited to offer the community two new services, and remind you about one existing service.



Starting in August, NPL began offering U.S. Passport services on a regular basis. Appointments are not needed. You can simply go to the library during the scheduled times to complete your application for a new passport. Payment can be done by check or money order only.

Also, NPL reminds that every Friday, from 9 – 12 Noon, you can video conference (face to face) with a Social Security representative. The equipment is set up in one of the library's study rooms, to ensure patrons' privacy. This is a walk-in service, with no appointment necessary to get answers to your questions. You can file for Social Security or SSI benefits, change your address and report other changes, and ask any questions that you may have. This is a free service, which has been available at NPL since the Norwalk Social Security office closed several years ago.

The library now has Notary Public service available on Thursdays, from 5:30 – 8 p.m. If you need a document notarized, simply ask at the Information Desk. There is no charge for this service.
