

Independent Order of Odd Fellows (I.O.O.F.)

Our Brother's Lodge No. 10, Question Book [Membership Applications], 1885-1902

The following table includes names from a book of preprinted application forms, with information given by prospective members and signed by the applicant. Key information on each applicant has been extracted and presented here in alphabetical order. The original volume includes a total of 254 applications, two to a page, by date. It is designated as OB-2b, shelved in Stack 3B, with other ledgers and account books of the order.

Each applicant was asked eight questions:

1. What is your name?
2. Where do you reside?
3. What is your occupation?
4. How old are you?
5. Do you hold membership in any other Order of Odd Fellows? Are you suspended or expelled from any Lodge of this Order?
6. Are you, so far as you know, in sound health?
7. Do you believe in the existence of a Supreme, Intelligent Being, the Creator and Preserver of the Universe?
8. Are you willing to subscribe to the truth of the answer you have now made?

This Norwalk fraternal lodge was instituted Oct. 19, 1842. It offered insurance for its members and supported charitable activities.
